Terms of Reference

1. **Composition of the Group**

Three pupils from each year group (Year 3 – 6) will make up the STEM Leaders group. Three pupils from Year 6 will be appointed as Lead STEM Leaders and will oversee the group's activities.

2. **Meeting Schedule**

Meetings will be held fortnightly on Mondays at 14:45 in a designated classroom. Special sessions may be held for planning larger events or projects.

3. **STEM Clinics**

STEM Leaders are expected to hold a lunchtime STEM clinic at least once a month on a rotating basis. These clinics will provide an opportunity for other pupils to engage in STEM activities, ask questions, or seek help with STEM-related topics.

4. **Feedback Responsibilities**

STEM Leaders are expected to communicate any updates or information from their meetings to their year groups promptly. This may include sharing new STEM projects, competitions, or school-wide initiatives.

5. **School Events and Representation**

STEM Leaders will be responsible for helping organize and lead STEM-related school events, including Science Fairs, Coding Clubs, and Technology showcases. They may also be asked to represent the school in external STEM events or interviews.

6. **School Improvement Projects**

Each STEM Leader is expected to take part in or lead a school improvement project focused on enhancing STEM learning in the school. These projects may come from the student's own proposals or be decided in group meetings.

7. **Role Model Expectations**

STEM Leaders are expected to embody the school's Guiding Powers, serving as role models for the entire school community. They should demonstrate curiosity, creativity, and collaboration in all STEM activities and interactions.

Success Criteria for STEM Leaders:

- Every member is committed to their role and responsibilities.
- The group works together, collaborates, and shares ideas effectively.
- STEM Leaders foster a love for science, technology, engineering, and maths within the school.
- They serve as role models and uphold the school's values and Guiding Powers.
